Easthampstead Golf Club Junior Membership Form

We are the Junior Section of Easthampstead Golf Club, which plays on the Downshire public golf course.

We run regular evening sessions as well as competitions where you can qualify for a handicap or improve the handicap you already have.

Easthampstead Golf Club is GolfMark accredited with Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks in accordance with current England Golf criteria for relevant volunteers.

We meet every Thursday evening, summer and winter from 6.30pm until 8pm. Activities during the sessions depend on the weather/light and tend to be on the pitch-and-putt in summer and on the driving-range in winter. The Downshire Golf Complex Professionals are available on a fortnightly basis and their tuition is covered by the session charge of £5. Other sessions cost £3 and prospective new members are welcome to attend to see if they would like to join.

The competitions we run are restricted to Members. We run competitions twice a month and also organise matches with the adult sections as well as with junior sections of other local clubs.

We operate in accordance with the World handicap System. In order to gain a handicap, you will need to play in our competitions and submit three cards. Your handicap will be based on the best of the three cards you submit.

We accept new members, boys and girls, from the age of 8 to 18. For members younger than 12 we ask that they attend a Thursday evening session with a parent/carer/guardian ("parent") first. Young golfers are also catered for by the Golf Academy, details are available from the pro-shop.

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CODE OF CONDUCT FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

Please review with your child and make sure that you both understand it.

This code of conduct has been written to ensure the enjoyment and development of junior golfers in a safe and equitable manner. It is the responsibility of every junior to uphold the highest behaviour standards expected, to enable the organisers, volunteers and coaches to effectively look after juniors:

- Treat all other golfers, whether adult or junior with the same respect and fairness you would like them to show you.
- All golfers should be able to participate in golf without fear of ridicule, harassment or restriction.
- Demonstrate fair play on and off the course. Respect differences in gender, disability, culture, race, ethnicity and religious beliefs between yourself and others.
- Challenge discrimination or prejudice, whether against others or against you. Speak out if you are concerned about you or those around you, no matter how small an issue you may feel it is.
- Challenge behaviour that falls below the expected standards of the golf club.
- Follow the club rules and dress codes.
- Be organised and on time.
- Tell someone in authority if you are leaving the venue.
- Always listen to the advice and guidance of the Junior Organiser and other members of staff and comply with their requests. They have your best interests and those of the whole group in mind.
- Be sensible and safe when using the driving range, make sure you are conscious of where those around you are when you are swinging a club. Do not climb on benches or up poles.
- Do not waste, misuse or abuse equipment; this includes golf clubs, golf balls and teaching equipment.
- On the course avoid slow play at all times, allow quicker groups to play through in order to avoid holding up others.
- Advise the Junior Organiser or Coach of any medical conditions which may affect your safety or standard of play.
- Do not engage in any irresponsible, abusive, inappropriate or illegal behaviour.
- Report anybody who is endangering themselves or their fellow golfers to a Junior Committee member or a member of staff.
