Our club has implemented a safeguarding and child protection policy. This policy applies to all club members with emphasis on juniors and vulnerable adults.

There are procedures to be followed in the event of any safeguarding issues or concerns in line with the policy laid down by England Golf. It is my role to ensure that all reasonable measures and procedures are in place to deliver that policy.

As you would expect, all our volunteers and staff who works with children must be checked against a police database (DBS check). Those who works more frequently with children will also have attended a safeguarding and child protection course, I have to ensure that their certificates are valid and up-to-date.

I am your first point of contact whether you are a club member, staff, volunteer, parent or junior on any issue concerning safeguarding of children, abuse or poor practice, potential or alleged abuse.

As the Welfare Officer I have no other role within the club and will therefore be able to represent you on any safeguarding issue with impartiality and in confidence.

I am a very approachable person so do get in contact with any concerns or queries you might have.



Investigation under disciplinary proceedings – including possible temporary suspension of person accused


Golf's investigation dependent upon outcome of advice from the Local Authority Designated Officer (LADO)/Team or Children's Social Care/Police investigation
