COMPETITION SIGN IN:

- 1. Players must sign in on the PC in the Pro-Shop at least 30 minutes prior to their allotted tee time.
- 2. Check in with the Pro-Shop staff in the Pro-Shop
- 3. Check in with the Starters based in the bar.

Failure to sign in on the PC prior to beginning your round will be deemed a late arrival and the player will receive the relevant penalty.

PENALTIES: NOSHOWS/WALK OFFS: 2 Match Ban. LATE ARRIVALS (INCLUDING 1ST TEE): 1st Offence – 1 Shot, 2nd Offence (In A Rolling 12 Month Period) - 2 Shots (To Be Taken on The First Hole). NO RETURNS: 3 No Returns (In a rolling 6-month period), Penalty – Discussion with the Handicap Committee. SLOW PLAY: 1 Shot (To Be Taken on The Last Hole).

ELIGIBILITY: EGC Member/WHS Handicap Held/Green & Entry Fee Paid

ENTRY FEE: £5.00 paid via your Competition Purse. Failure to pay the Entry Fee will result in players being excluded from winning prizes in this Competition.

PRIZES AWARDED: Up to 20 players: 1st & 2nd 21-26 players 1st, 2nd & 3rd. 27-30 players: 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th. 31+ players 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th. Overall winners must have completed a minimum of 6 rounds in EGC Handicap Qualifying Competitions in the previous 12 months, and Divisional prize winners must have completed a minimum of 3 rounds in EGC Handicap Qualifying Competitions in the previous 12 months. This means you are eligible to win divisional prizes in your 4th qualifying competition and can be an overall winner in your 7th qualifying competition.

TIED SCORES: If scores are tied the result will be decided on Countback over the last 9 holes, then last 6 holes, then last 3 holes then the final hole.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES: Allowed in accordance with Rule 4-3 of the Rules of Golf

AUDIO/VISUAL EQUIPMENT: During a round, a player must not listen to or watch content of any nature on a personal audio or video device. Penalty for breach of rule: 1st Offence - 2 Shots (to be taken on the next hole after being used), 2nd Offence: Disqualification.

CADDIES: Allowed in accordance with Rule 10-3 of the Rules of Golf

BALL MARKING: Although not specifically required, at EGC it is mandatory that you mark your ball(s) for identification purposes during your round.
