<u>LAST MONTH'S MINUTES</u>	<u>ACTION</u>
Minutes of the last meeting: 23 October 2025 having been previously circulated were agreed.	
<u>Matters Arising / Actions from previous meetings</u> Centre management meetings? Al This has been discussed with Simon, the best way forward seems to be for Al to meet with Simon periodically, informally. Ladies have been forwarding to me some of the comms shared within the Men's section which is also useful. Changing rooms - Al Quotes are being sought and money has been set aside in the new financial year (April 2026) budget for the toilets and sinks to be replaced, and new flooring fitted. It is not financially viable to knock the wall down between the toilets and the changing room. They are still trying to establish the exact cause of the damp problem next to the shower area. I asked him whether the showers would be replaced or just removed. He said they would probably be replaced. I expressed a concern that women would feel very vulnerable showering in there and suggested he	

considers a shower cubicle on one side and a small changing area on the other, all of which is lockable. I also asked whether it would be possible to have it ready for the Anniversary Waltz, with Edmee cutting the ribbon!

Secretary role - Al & Gill

We will take the minutes today and next month, after which I will email the club to ask if anyone would consider stepping in. If there are no volunteers would everyone on the committee be prepared to take it in turns to do the minutes? The committee agreed they would.

REPORTS

Captain's report

All competitions have gone ahead in November and so far in December. It is very wet underfoot, but very encouragingly most players are now choosing to carry. The decision was made to make all of the friendly comps in December only 9 holes, with a reminder that players are still able to continue to the back 9 should they wish. This has been well received.

Simon reports that a number of the men are using the playing mats that are on sale in the pro-shop. He has no objection to these being used on tees or on the fairway if we wanted to use them in friendly comps (these cannot be used in qualifying comps, but the mats can if all players use them [needs fact-checking!]).

A very positive discussion has been had with Simon regarding the status of the changing room and also the possibility of a 9-hole rate for members playing in club comps.

The two Christmas events were well supported and I think fun was had by all. The decision to play on the range rather than the course before lunch on Sunday seemed popular. Speaking to Simon afterwards he said that if we decide to do that in the future the centre could have mulled wine or a glass of prosecco brought out to the range to make more of an event of it.

The Christmas Hamper raffle raised £250 for charity, and Chris Smith has raised £29.50 from the sale of her towels. Total money raised for Daisy's Dream so far is an impressive £449.24.

The draw has taken place and ELGC are fielding teams in regions 1, 2 & 4. Initial emails have been sent out to the other clubs. Region 2 clubs have responded and we have matches arranged for 10th January (The Oaks) and 17th January (Home). Team A for this region has been selected. Tees have been booked for the home match and a decision regarding catering is pending. (The other clubs in regions 1 and 4 have not responded yet.)</p> <p>After discussion of various options, it was agreed that sandwiches and chips would be provided, but no drink.</p>	
<p><u>Social Secretary</u></p> <p>I am yet to send out an email encouraging members to message if they book a casual tee time & would like other members to join them for a game. We could find out when the members have free time. I know in friend groups this is already happening, but this would be more inclusive and encouraging to all, especially new members. I'll send a message on the New Members WhatsApp group too. If members of the committee & more experienced players started the ball rolling that would be helpful.
